

Summer Food Service Program

Stressing the importance of offering nutritious meals to children during the summer months, the Royall School District announces the sponsorship of the Summer Food Service Program.

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), which is funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and is administered by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, provides nutritious meals to children during the summer, when free and reduced-price schools meals are typically unavailable. Free meals will be made available to eligible children 18 years of age and under. Persons over 18 years of age who are determined by a state or local public educational agency to be mentally or physically disabled and who also participate in a public or private non-profit school program during the regular school year may receive free meals as well.

The following locations will be serving the free meals this summer Royall Elementary School Cafeteria starting June 5 – June 29 (Monday – Thursday). Breakfast will be served from 7:30am-8:15am and Lunch will be served from 11:30am-12:30pm. Meals are provided to eligible children regardless of race, color, national origin, age, gender or disability and there will be no discrimination in the course of meal service. Starting July 5 lunches will be available from 11:30am-12:30pm at the Elroy Library and at Glenwood Park in Kendall. Lunches will be available July 5-July 27 (Monday-Thursday)

“This program fills a void created when school meals are not available,” said Jennifer Jennings. “Helping parents meet the nutritional needs of their children is the strength of this program.”
