

Notification of Royall School District Student Assessments

(pursuant of 2015 Wisconsin Act 55, state budget bill-section 118.30(1m)(d) of the state statutes) to annually publish information on the district’s internet site about the 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th grade examinations administered to the students enrolled in the district)

Royall School District requires the following assessment of their students. Some are district assessment and some are state assessments. Please see the chart below.

Assessment	Grade	Frequency	Domain	Purpose
My IGDIs	4K	Fall and Spring	State	Individual Growth and Development Indicators: Essential screening, diagnostic, and progress monitoring tool for measuring fundamental concepts of literacy.
STAR	1-6	Quarterly	District	Measure and monitors student progress in reading.
AIMSWEB	K-8	Fall/Winter/ Spring/Progress monitoring	District	Measures and monitors student progress in the area of reading and math.
Wisconsin Forward Exam	3-8 and 10	Spring	State	Beginning in spring 2016, Wisconsin students in grades 3 through 8 will take the Forward Exam. The new custom assessment will be administered in English language arts and mathematics in grades 3 through 8, in science in grades 4 and 8, and in social studies in 4, 8, and 10.
ACCESS for ELLS		Fall	State	Federal and state laws require that students identified as English Learners (EL) be assessed annually to determine their level of English language proficiency (ELP) and ensure that they are progressing in achieving full English proficiency. This includes students who receive special education services.
DLM	3-11	Spring	State (Cognitively Disabled students)	The DLM assessment measures the academic progress of students with significant cognitive disabilities in the subject areas of English language arts and mathematics <i>for students in grades 3-11</i> as well as science for students in grades 4 and 8-11. This is an online assessment delivered either via the computer; however, some students may need their teacher to present the items to them. The teacher will then enter the student’s response into the online platform.
ACT Aspire	9-10	Spring	State	ACT Aspire Early High School is a summative assessment that measures what students have learned in the areas of: English, Reading, Math, Science, and Writing.
ACT	11	Spring	State	Consists of four multiple-choice tests: English, Mathematics, Reading and Science and a 30 minute essay tests that measure writing skills.

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
