

**ROYALL SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**Open Enrollment Special Education Cap Recommendations**  
**2025-2026 School Year**

The following Open Enrollment recommendations for the Royall School District were developed according to the guidance of the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. These guidelines use a specific set of considerations for caseloads that assists in determining what spaces might be available in the next school year. When considering the number of slots available for Open Enrollment, the district made space determinations based on the following criteria:

- WCASS Special Education Service Matrix (Feb 2024)
- current caseloads
- the capacity of current staff and buildings
- students currently attending the school district
- \*projected enrollment for next year
  - +2 for Elementary/Intermediate/HS
  - +4 for EC
  - 10% for Speech/Language

The district will have a process in place to evaluate specific requests beyond the above designated allotment.
